

What is the Mac Club?

The Mac Club is a service club to Laguna Woods Village residents, located on the 3rd floor of the Community Center. Like all clubs in the Village, we operate under the Recreation Department's rules and guidelines, and our Bylaws. The Village is fortunate that GRF provides the facility and Apple computers for the use of our community. This facility is the Mac Club's Learning Center, or Mac Lab.

The primary mission of the Mac Club is to provide access to the Apple computing facility for the use of residents. When residents visit the room to use a computer, we are fulfilling our primary mission.

Helping residents with questions or problems with their Apple devices is another important and secondary mission. All volunteers happily perform this mission to the best of our ability, but if a particular Room Supervisor is not able to help with your specific question or problem, we usually have another one who can.

An additional mission of the Mac Club is to provide other services not provided by GRF. These include our many classes on Apple devices taught by volunteer instructors, printing documents from your iPhone or iPad, and scanning documents and photos. Equipment such as classroom tables, large screen TVs, media equipment, printers and scanners are purchased by your memberships and donations without GRF financial help.

Providing these services would not be possible without a group of dedicated volunteers. In addition to the Room Supervisors we have volunteers managing our equipment, finances, website, membership, communications, teaching, and serving on our Board of Directors.
