Director Skillman commented ramps have been installed previously. She is in agreement with Director Bastani and we have to be careful with anything we do concerning the common area.

Advisor Dorrell mentioned she has no objections with the ramp; her concern is who the ramp is for, the shareholder or the lessee.

Director Randazzo commented he has been in contact with many contractors recently and though they originally mentioned there was a problem with the Permits Office and not with the city, now that has turned 100% and the problems lays with the city. Director Randazzo asked that a meeting with the contractors be held as soon as possible to address their concerns otherwise issues with the obtaining contractors in LWV will never get better. The meeting should happen in the Community Center. Mr. Crane indicated that he is working on it.

Director Bastani stated the reasoning behind his objection of the ramp is that it will set a precedence and many will request the same. Interim Chair Randazzo commented that precedence has already been made with elevators.
