#### STAFF REPORT

SUBJECT: Off-Schedule Tree Trimming Request: 14-C Via Castilla – Aleppo Pine and

**Pittosporum Trees** 

#### RECOMMENDATION

Approve the request for the off-schedule trimming of one Aleppo Pine and one Pittosporum tree located at 14-C Via Castilla.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The requestor became a Member in September 2020, and is requesting the off-schedule trimming of one Aleppo Pine tree, *Pinus halepensis*, and one Pittosporum tree, *Pittosporum viridiflorum*, located in the sloped shrub bed area at the front of the unit.

The reason cited for the trimming request is a tree litter. (Attachment 1).

Trimming is tentatively scheduled for fiscal year 2024 for the Aleppo Pine. This tree species is on a six-year trimming cycle. Trimming is tentatively scheduled for fiscal year 2026 for the Pittosporum tree. This tree species is on a four-year trimming cycle.

The height of the Aleppo pine tree is approximately 40-50 feet, with a trunk diameter of approximately 30 inches and 15 inches respectively. The trees are growing approximately five feet from the common sidewalk (Attachment 2).

#### DISCUSSION

At the time of the inspection, the trees were found to be in fair health with balanced canopies. There were no signs of pests or prior pest activity. There was small amount of deadwood in both canopies and no decay present. There were no surface roots visible.

While investigating the litter concerns, staff noticed that the Aleppo pine tree extends out over the roof, but with no tree canopy contact with the roof. Crown thinning of the trees to avoid conflict with the roof and rebalancing the canopy shape would effectively reduce potential future tree-related liabilities.

While leaf litter alone would not constitute an off-schedule trimming, the Aleppo pine in question has some dead limbs, and in conjunction with the need to trim both trees to prevent tree crown competition, it would be prudent to trim both trees concurrently.

The Pittosporum tree meets the parameters set forth in §3.2.2.1, Tree Pruning Recommendations, of the United Mutual Urban Forest Management Plan. Staff recommends that the off-schedule trimming be approved.

#### **FINANCIAL ANALYSIS**

The recurring cost to trim the Pittosporum tree is \$800. The estimated value of the trees is \$3,260 based on the tree inventory data.
