

2022 VILLAGE GAMES Monday, April 11, to Monday, May 2

There are 20 sports scheduled throughout the community: archery, basketball, billiards, bocce ball, bridge (progressive), equestrian, 18-hole and 9-hole golf, par-3 golf, lawn bowling, paddle tennis, petanque, outdoor pickleball, poker, shuffleboard, swimming, table tennis, target shooting, tennis and volleyball.

ELIGIBILITY: As safety is of primary concern, individual or team competitors must have a valid Laguna Woods Village ID card. A waiver is required and must be signed prior to participation. Some sports will require additional waivers to be signed at the venue.

FEES: Registration fees include an event t-shirt, a closing ceremony invitation and medal eligibility. Additional fees for some sports (bridge, golf and target shooting) are to be paid by the participant at the venue. **No refunds.**

- March 1 March 18: \$10 for two sports; \$5 each additional sport
- March 21 March 25: \$15 for two sports; \$5 each additional sport
- March 28 April 1: \$20 for two sports; \$5 each additional sport
- April 4 April 8: \$25 for two sports; \$5 each additional sport

REGISTRATION: Register at the Community Fitness Center at 24351 El Toro Road during regular operating hours. Find details of each competition in the attached registration packet. Each competitor must complete a registration form. No changes to the registration form may be made once turned in. If a sport requires a partner, participants must fill out partner's page with name of desired partner. Registration is open until the hard cutoff date determined by the sport coordinator. **Payment must be made by check (payable to GRF) or credit card; cash will not be accepted.**

SHIRT PICKUP: Registered participants may pick up their event shirt beginning Monday, March 30, at the Community Fitness Center. No exchanges.

CHECK-IN: Participants should check in no less than 15 minutes prior to the start of their sport unless otherwise noted. If a participant has not checked in prior to the sport starting, a forfeit will be announced. Some sports require earlier check in. Please reference schedule and information.

ATTIRE: Participants are encouraged to wear their Village Games shirt to support the event and sponsors. Other athletic attire suitable for the event is acceptable.

CLOSING CEREMONY: Monday, May 2, Clubhouse 5 Main Lounge, doors open 9 a.m. Closing ceremony will feature a presentation, sponsor booths and a continental breakfast for registered participants and sponsors. Participants must wear their Village Games t-shirt for entry.
