





- CHANNEL 3 ANALOG GUIDE USERS WILL NEED AN HD DEVICE TO **GET NEW IGUIDE**


After Friday, May 31, Broadband Services is discontinuing the Channel 3 analog television guide. This means that a channel guide will no longer be available to those Residents whose televisions are plugged directly into the wall cable outlet. In order to receive the company's new digital interactive guide, Residents must rent an HD converter for \$7.95 per month or

any of our other HD set-top boxes. Renting the HD converter gives Residents the most up-todate digital iGuide available and eliminates the need for periodic channel scans—channels simply will display the correct number. The HD set-top devices also eliminate the need for
