

PROCEDURES AMENDMENT The resolution to amend Third Mutual's Golf Cart Policies and Procedures adds a separate fine for golf cart owners cited by the mutual for using mutual electricity without having purchased an annual electric golf cart decal. An article in the May 2019 Village Breeze incorrectly listed the fine for the first violation as \$50. The first violation is in fact \$100; fines increase in increments of \$50 for subsequent violations. The fines are capped at \$250.
