On Friday, June 21, in Clubhouse 5 from 10 a.m. to noon, the Orange County Registrar of Voters (OCROV) will be holding a community workshop to discuss future polling options in Laguna Woods Village. The passage of the California Voter's Choice Act (Senate Bill 450) in 2016 now permits counties to conduct elections using vote centers instead of polling places. In February, the Orange County Board of Supervisors voted to move forward with the transition from the polling-place model to the vote-center model. The OCROV currently is reviewing sites to serve as locations for in-person voting in the March 2020 presidential primary election. The OCROV presentation will include an overview of the vote-center model and provide the opportunity for Residents to contribute suggestions regarding the transition. Village
